ORDINANCE NO. 1406

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING  
THE CODE OF MARSEILLES AS TO RESPONSIBLE BIDDER

WHEREAS, the City of Marseilles is required to let construction contracts to the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder; and,

WHEREAS, this Council desires to maintain its regulations concerning such bidders with those kept by the LaSalle County Board;

WHEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARSEILLES, ILLINOIS that following text of Chapter 36 Finance and Revenue, Section §36.21 Responsible Bidder Defined of the *Code of Marseilles* is amended to reflect the addition of the following **bold text**:

§ 36.21 RESPONSIBLE BIDDER DEFINED.

(A) The term *RESPONSIBLE BIDDER* for construction means a bidder **and all bidder's sub-contractors** who meets all of the following applicable criteria, and submits evidence of such compliance:

- (1) All applicable laws pre-requisite to doing business in Illinois;
- (2) Evidence of compliance with:
  - (a) Federal employer tax identification number or social security number (for individuals);
  - (b) Provision of Section 2000(e) of Chapter 21, Title 42 of the United States Code and Federal Executive Order No. 11246 as amended by Executive Order No. 11375 (known as the Equal Opportunity Employer provisions).
- (3) Certificates of insurance indicating the following coverages; general liability, worker's compensation, completed operations, automobile, hazardous occupation, product liability, and professional liability.
- (4) Compliance with all provisions of the Illinois Prevailing Wage Act, including wages, medical and hospitalization insurance and retirement for those trades as covered in the Act.
- (5) Participation in **active** apprenticeship and training programs approved and registered with the United States Department of Labor's Bureau of Apprenticeship and Training **for each trades of work contemplated under the awarded contract.**

(B) Nothing herein shall be construed to affect any suit or proceeding now pending in any court or any rights accrued or liability incurred or cause or causes of action accrued or existing under any prior resolution or ordinance. Nor shall any right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired, or affected by this section.
