

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING
CHAPTER 36 OF THE VILLAGE CODE OF ORDINANCES

WHEREAS, the Village has determined that it is necessary to define the term "responsible" as the same applies to competitively bid contracts for the construction of public improvements within the Village of Romeoville, and to otherwise update the provisions of Chapter 36 pertaining to bidding.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES FOR THE VILLAGE OF ROMEOVILLE, WILL COUNTY, ILLINOIS; THAT
:

SECTION 1: RECITALS. The foregoing recitals are hereby incorporated into this Ordinance as if fully set forth herein.

SECTION 2: Amendment to Chapter 36.43 of the Village Code of Ordinances. The provisions of Chapter 36.43(A) shall be amended as hereinafter set forth, and codified as set forth below:

(a) Pursuant to the provisions of 65 ILCS 5/8-9-1, the reference to the sum of \$10,000.00 in Chapter 36.43(A) shall be stricken and replaced with a reference to the sum of \$20,000.00.

(b) The following additional text shall be added to the end of the existing Chapter 36.43(A) and codified therein:

As used in this Chapter 36.43(A), a responsible bidder shall mean a bidder that meets all requirements and qualifications established in the notice to bidders and bid packages prepared by and distributed by the Village to prospective bidders, and that also complies with or satisfies and furnishes evidence of compliance with or satisfaction of the following standards and requirements: (i) all laws, regulations and ordinances applicable to doing business in Illinois or performing the work contemplated by the proposed contract, (ii) possession of a valid federal employer identification number (for entities) or social security number (for individuals), (iii) Section 2000(c) of Title 42, Chapter 21, United States Code and Executive Order No. 11246, as amended by Executive Order 11375 (pertaining to equal opportunity employment), (iv) certificates of insurance providing for general liability coverage, workers' compensation coverage, completed operations coverage, automobile liability coverage, hazardous occupation coverage and product liability coverage, all in such amounts and in such forms as may be

from time to time set forth in the bid packages issued by the Village, (v) all provisions of the Illinois Prevailing Wage Act, and (vi) provision of certified payrolls by all contractors and subcontractors pursuant to Illinois Public Act 94-0515.

SECTION 3: SEVERABILITY. That the various provisions of this Ordinance are to be considered severable and if any part or portion of this Ordinance shall be held invalid by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance.


SECTION 4: CONFLICTS. All prior Ordinances and Resolutions, or parts thereof in conflict or inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby expressly repealed only to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency.

SECTION 5: REPEALER. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be, and the same are hereby repealed.


SECTION 6: EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.



Summary: The proposed ordinance adds a definition of responsible bidder (as used in Chapter 36) to the Village code of ordinance. In addition to applicable contract/bid specifications, the ordinance provides that responsible bidders must comply with all applicable laws, Federal executive requirements concerning equal opportunity, applicable Village insurance requirements, Illinois prevailing wage and certified payroll laws, and possess and maintain a valid FEIN or SSN.


