

ORDINANCE NO. 04- 13

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1-2-26 OF CHAPTER 1 OF THE REVISED CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE VILLAGE OF OREANA, ILLINOIS (ORDINANCE #300) CONCERNING BIDDING AND CONTRACT PROCEDURES

WHEREAS, the Village of Oreana has the authority to adopt ordinances and promulgate rules and regulations concerning the bidding and letting of contracts, pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/8-9-1; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Oreana has previously adopted a Revised Code of Ordinances (Ordinance #300); and

WHEREAS, Chapter 1 of Ordinance #300, the Revised Code of Ordinances for the Village of Oreana, pertains to Administration; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees has determined that it is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of its citizens to amend Section 1-2-26 of Chapter 1 of the Revised Code of Ordinances for the Village of Oreana regarding the bidding and letting of construction contracts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Oreana, Macon County, Illinois as follows:

1. That Section 1-2-26 of Chapter 1 is hereby amended to add a subparagraph (N) as follows:

“(N) CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS EXCEEDING \$25,000. In all contracts for the construction of new facilities, renovation of current facilities or road projects, the estimated cost of which exceeds \$25,000.00, a responsible bidder is hereby defined to be a bidder who meets all of the following applicable criteria, and submits evidence of such compliance:

- (1) All applicable laws prerequisite to doing business in Illinois.
- (2) Evidence of compliance with:
 - (a) Federal Employer Tax Identification Number or Social Security Number for individuals.
 - (b) Provision of Section 2000(e) of Chapter 21, Title 42 of the United States Code and Federal Executive Order No. 11246 as amended by Executive Order No. 11375 (known as the Equal Opportunity Employer Provisions).
- (3) Certificate of insurance indicating the following coverages: general liability, worker’s compensation, completed operations, automobile, hazardous occupation, and professional liability.

- (4) Compliance with all provisions of the Illinois Prevailing Wage Act, including wages, medical and hospitalization insurance and retirement for those trades covered in the Act.
- (5) Participation in apprenticeship and training programs approved and registered with the United States Department of Labor's Bureau of Apprenticeship and Training."



Pursuant to Chapter 1, Sections 1-1-3 and 1-1-4, the Village Clerk is hereby directed to effect the amendment of the Revised Code of Ordinances by forwarding a copy of this ordinance to the Village Attorney, as a codifier, for preparation of proper materials to be inserted in all copies of the Code.


This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form.
